WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- **Refugees**
- **Refugee Secondary Migrants:** refugees who have moved to the Triad area from another city or state
- **Asylees** who have been granted asylum immigration status in the United States
- **Cuban and Haitian Parolees** who have been granted paroled immigration status in the United States
- **Survivors of Human Trafficking** with Continued Presence or T-Visa
- **Special Immigrant Visa (SIV) Holders**

❖ You must have arrived in the United States within the **past 5 years** and have an eligible immigration status (listed above) to receive World Relief's Employment Services.

You must present your I-94 and/or court order showing immigration status.
