

Refugee Resettlement

Services: Case Management, Basic Needs, Cultural Orientation, Referrals for Ongoing Resources

Eligible Population: Refugees and SIVs for up to 90 days after arrival. Refugees must arrive through World Relief Triad or be officially transferred to be eligible for services

Opportunity Services

Employment Services: Orientation/Enrollment, Job Readiness Training, Resume Development, Assistance in Job Search, Transportation to/from job interviews, job placement and follow-up, career counseling, assistance with translation and transfer of degrees/credits

Youth Mentoring: Ages 15-24, group and individual mentoring (High Point)

Eligible Population: Refugees, SIVs, Asylees, Parolees, and Victims of Human Trafficking within first 5 years

Health & Wellness

Case Management Services: Intensive Case Management, Referrals for Ongoing Resources, Health & Psychoeducation classes

Eligible Population: Medically Vulnerable Refugees, SIVs, Asylees, Parolees, & Victims of Human Trafficking within first 5 years

Therapy Services: Individual, Family, and Couple Counseling, Support Groups, RHS-15 Assessments, Referrals to other providers, Certified Trauma Therapy

Eligible Population: Documented and Un-Documented Immigrants

Immigration Legal Services

Services: Green Card, Naturalization, Family Reunification (AOR/CAM), DACA Renewals, Employment Authorization, I-130, Green Card Renewals/Replacements, Reentry Permits/Travel Documents, Consular Process/Immigrant Visa Applications, & T-Visas

Eligible Population: Documented and certain Un-Documented Immigrants

Anti-Human Trafficking

Direct Services and Referrals Include: Shelter/Housing, food and clothing assistance, interpretation, medical/dental services, mental/behavioral health services, legal services, transportation, education, and job development

Eligible Population: Foreign National Survivors of Human Trafficking rescued in NC and the US, US Citizens, and Legal Permanent Resident survivors in the Triad. Assistance in collaboration with the Triad Rapid Response Team and other community partners
